



Free Days at Denver Museums & Attractions 2019

Visiting museums can get expensive, especially for families. However, many museums offer **FREE** admission at least once a month — some even offer special activities on those days. The free days are funded, in part, by taxes collected through the Science and Cultural Facilities District.

Because free days are, well, **FREE**, expect large crowds and plan accordingly. Arrive early to secure a parking spot or consider using public transit. **Note:** While admission is free, special exhibitions or other add-on activities may incur a fee. Dates may change, so it's always best to double-check before you plan your visit.

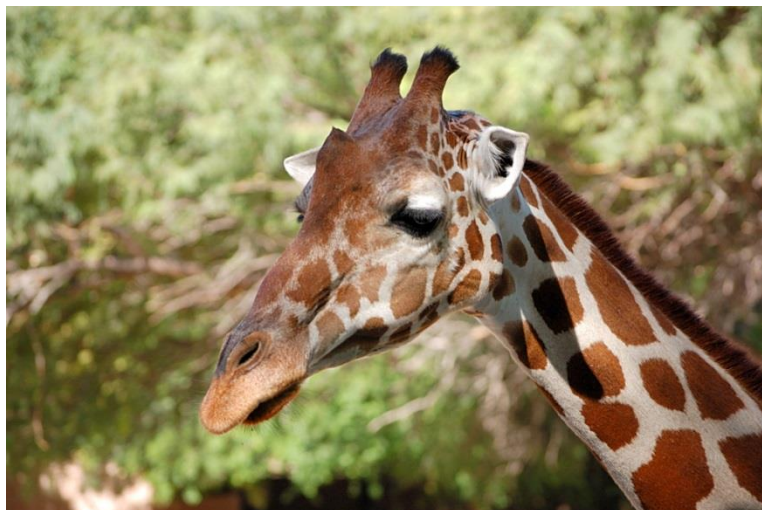
