FREE Days 2020

Visiting museums can get expensive, especially for families. However, many museums offer **FREE** admission every month — some even offer special activities on those days. The free days are funded, in part, by taxes collected through the Science and Cultural Facilities District.

Because free days are so popular, expect large crowds and plan accordingly. Arrive early to secure a parking spot or consider using public transportation or a rideshare. **Note:** While admission is free, special exhibitions or other add-on activities may incur a fee. Dates are subject to change, so always double-check before you visit.
